

TR STORYTIME

DESCRIPTION

EQUIPMENT:

- o Pictures
- o Audio file of the story
- o Good audio (a speaker is recommended)

BEFORE YOU START:

- Hang up the pictures in the correct order.
- Get the audio file ready, and connected to a good speaker.
- Maybe split the tweens up into groups beforehand.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Split up into groups with max 5 tweens (can be done beforehand).
- 2. Go to the story hanging on the wall. Let the tweens guess what might have happened with Emma and what she's thinking.
- 3. Sit down in a circle and dim the lights. Make it a vibe.
- 4. Play the story about Emma.
- 5. Ask the questions one at a time and talk to the tweens about each one.

NOTE FOR MENTORS:

It is easier to talk about a story than about yourself, even though you're speaking about situations which you might have experienced personally. The pictures will help the tweens to relate to Emma.

QUESTIONS:

- 1. Does Emma have reason to feel impure?
- Do you have any good tips for what she could do?
- What does this verse mean?
