STORYTIME

DESCRIPTION

EQUIPMENT:

- Pictures
- Audio file of the story
- Good audio (a speaker is recommended)

BEFORE YOU START:

- Hang up the pictures in the correct order.
- Get the audio file ready, and connected to a good speaker.
- Maybe split the tweens up into groups beforehand.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Split up into groups with max 5 tweens (can be done beforehand).
2. Go to the story hanging on the wall. Let the tweens guess what might have happened with Emma and what she's thinking.
3. Sit down in a circle and dim the lights. Make it a vibe.
4. Play the story about Emma.
5. Ask the questions one at a time and talk to the tweens about each one.

NOTE FOR MENTORS:

It is easier to talk about a story than about yourself, even though you're speaking about situations which you might have experienced personally. The pictures will help the tweens to relate to Emma.

QUESTIONS:

1. Does Emma have reason to feel impure?
2. Do you have any good tips for what she could do?
3. What does this verse mean?
